THE CONYNGHAM SHAFT EXPLOSION.

WILKESBARRE, Penn., Nov. 28.-Walter O'Niell, another victim of Friday's explosion at the Conyngham shaft, died this evening. Michael O'Brien and Hugh Cannon, two of the most seriously injured, are not expected to live more than a few hours. Thomas O'Brien died at 3 o'clock this afternoon, although his death was announced in many papers yesterday. Dr. A. P. O'Malley, who is attending 25 of the victims, is of the opinion that all the others of those injured will recover. The Coroner's investigation, commenced yesterday, tends to show that the company were to blame for the accident. O'Brien on his deathbed denied that there were any danger signals, and this statement is confirmed by the testimony of several other miners.
