
SCRANTON, Penn., Aug. 25.—Frank Decker, one of the guards employed by the Temple Iron Company at the Edgerton colliery, was to-day placed under \$2,000 bonds on the charge of shooting Foreman Connelly and Forrest Crossman last Monday night. Up to the present time the belief had been general that the shooting was done by the strikers. Crossman says he believes Decker shot believing Connelly and himself were strikers intent on mischief.
