SCRANTON, Penn., May 20.—The Glendale coal breaker, situated about a mile from this city, was struck by lightning during a storm this afternoon and totally destroyed. Loss, \$35,000; insurance, \$10,000. The property belonged to the Pennsylvania Anthracite Coal Company, and was operated by the Glendale Company under a lease.
