MINE CAVE-IN CONTINUES.

More Houses Damaged at Mayfield, Penn.—One Destroyed by Fire.

SCRANTON, Penn., April 23.—The mine cave-in of the Glenwood Collieries' surface at Mayfield, this county, continued to-day. Already over twenty houses have been damaged. The damage to the Greek Catholic Church is greater than reported last night.

The house of Lavon Hutick, which went down four feet, caught fire, and was destroyed, there being no means of fighting the fire, owing to the broken water pipes. The people of the place are wildly excited

to-day.
