
LOSSES BY FIRE.

—The Thompson and Knapp Blocks at Malone, N. Y., in which were the wholesale hardware store of Thompson Brothers, J. J. Murphy's general merchandise store, and the law offices of F. G. Paddock and J. C. Saunders, burned yesterday. Loss, \$50,000; insurance, \$40,000.

—Fire at Dallas, Texas, destroyed A. P. Block's wall paper house, C. Ott's gun store, A. J. Knight's wall paper house, and American Express office. Loss, \$100,000; insurance, \$50,000.

—The boarding house of the American Electric Works at Phillipsdale, R. I., was burned. Loss, \$12,000.

—The mule barn of the Greenwood breaker, Soranton, Penn., with thirty-six mules, was burned. Loss, \$15,000.
