Killed by Lightning Stroke. SCRANTON, Penn., July 7.-John Regala was instantly killed, and three other men severely shocked by a bolt of lightning that struck the Murray coal breaker at Dunmore, near here, last night. The breaker was damaged to the extent of about \$10,000, and will have to be rebuilt. This was the third time in five years that this breaker has been struck by lightning, and each time some person was killed. Last night's killed and injured were employes.
