

Mines Cave In at Scranton.

SCRANTON, Penn., March 12.—A serious cave-in of the Spencer mines occurred to-day at Dunmore, causing a surface disturbance of more than 700 feet long and 100 feet in width. Four residences were so badly wrecked as to render them uninhabitable. No work can be done for several days.
