\$400,000 Coal Break Fire.

WILKESBARRE, Penn., Nv. 20.—The Stanton breaker of the Wilkesbarre Coal Company in the southern section of this city was destroyed by fire to-night. 'Ine timbers, covered with dust and oil, the accumulation of years, were very inflammable, and in less than an hour the building was in ruins. The breaker contained all the latest modern machinery. The loss is estimated at \$100,000. Several hundred men are made idle by the fire.
